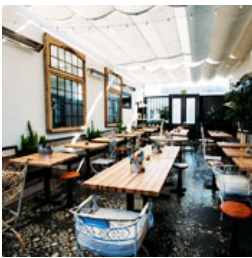
THE FRITES COME OUT AT NIGHT
